P086/17 Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr Mrs M Denham

P087/17 Declarations of Interests

Cllr R Ives and Mrs L Spelman Ives declared a non prejudicial interest in the application and did not vote.

Cllr Bradford stated that, as a member of the Planning Authority's Development Committee he would not take part in the discussion on the application.

PO88/17 Community Time

Cllr Bradford welcomed Mrs de Vries from the Planning Department and Mr Durant representing Bloor Homes to the meeting. Cllr Spencer then took over the chair.

After an initial introduction to the plans by Mr Durant, members of the public raised a number of issues. These included:

There was concern that it was only a two form primary school that was being proposed, as a new secondary school was also needed. The application was an outline one for the school site, if approved it would be up to the Education Authority to take the matter further.

There was widespread concern about the width of roads on the proposed plan, particularly along the access route to the school. Given the problems on the neighbouring major developments, repeating the same approach was felt to be misguidedand short sighted. Mr Durant stated that minimum standards were being met. Mrs de Vries said that the response from the Highways Authority was awaited. The view was expressed that access via Rhode Lane would be better, but this option had not been accepted by the Highways Authority in the past.

Mr Durant stated that no affordable homes were included in the plans because of the other public realm facilities being provided. There were also no bungalows proposed.

Whilst welcoming the provision of a much needed primary school and community facility, the Council objects to the application as currently submitted on the following

grounds:

The access to the site via Campion Way and Willstock Way is already over capacity

for existing traffic, with major congestion problems at peak times.

The roads on the proposed development are too narrow, which, as with

neighbouring developments, will cause serious traffic and safety issues. This will be

particularly true in relation to the school access route.

There is inadequate parking provision, which will add to the problems identified

above.
